
Pryvitne Ternopillya

After February 24, Ternopil Oblast began receiving thousands of Ukrainians from communities where active hostilities are taking place and from the frontline territories. In order for the guests of Ternopil region to have a more comfortable stay, we launched Pryvitne Ternopillya initiative, which includes:

- **A video clip about the locations and services that operate for IDPs,**
- **Developed a page on the website,**
- **Printed booklets with the necessary information,**
- **Delivered information to guests through social networks, boards and city lights,**
- **We created a Telegram chat and a Telegram channel.**

The initiative "Privitne Ternopillya" was included among the best practices in Ukraine in the field of cooperation between civil society, business and government.

The project is implemented in partnership with Ternopil City Council, Ternopil Regional Military Administration and advertising agency "Marketing Technologies PBS" with the support of the European Endowment for Democracy (EED).



HUB for relocated civil activists and journalists

Since the beginning of the full-scale war, the organization's office has turned into a Hub for relocated activists and journalists. All conditions for work have been created in – workplaces, Internet, office equipment and other amenities. Journalists and civil activists can use all this absolutely free of charge.

In general, during this initiative, more than **40 activists** and journalists who relocated to Ternopil used it.

Accommodation compensation for activists and journalists

At the first days of the war, team of the NGO "Educationally-analytical center of community development" in partnership with the National Endowment for Democracy (NED) launched an initiative of compensation for rented housing specifically for journalists and civil activists in order to protect them from threats that were in the zone of active hostilities.

Since the launch of the initiative, the organization has received **236 requests** for help. In total, the team of the organization helped **683 displaced people**, of which **395 were adults and 288 children**.

Accommodation compensation for activists and journalists from Mariupol

Since the program for compensation of funds for rented housing for journalists and civil activists was active during the blockade of Mariupol, it was decided to make a separate initiative during the organization of the **"green corridor"**.

Thus, we received **22 applications**. In total, **66 journalists**, activists and members of their families from Mariupol received help.

Community friendly to business


As part of the project in the Velyko Berezovytska Community were:




Collection of signatures under the appeal for the establishment of a coordinating body for the support and development of the public sector

The team of our organization initiated the collection of signatures under an appeal to the Embassies of friendly countries, technical assistance organizations, international funds, and the Secretariat of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine regarding the creation of a coordinating body for the support and development of the public sector.

The initiative was supported by **60 public organizations** from different regions of Ukraine. The appeal has already been sent to **48 international foundations**, technical assistance organizations, and embassies of friendly countries as well as to **the Secretariat of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine**



The initiative is designed to reduce the number of traffic accidents during the dark period of the day. Within its framework, reflective tapes are distributed free of charge to school-aged children of Ternopil city and Ternopil oblast.

In general, more than **2700 children** received more than **8000 reflective tapes**. Schools from the entire Ternopil oblast joined the initiative.

Online video course for public organizations

Our team participated in the development of a training video course, which is designed to help NGOs to adapt to new conditions, strengthen capacity and plan further activities, taking into account the challenges of wartime.

January 27-28

Forum "Transparency of local government: myths and reality", which was held in the city of Ternopil as part of the "Centre of public activity development" project



February 18

Webinar "No panic: how to be prepared for various crisis situations?"

Webinar participants received comprehensive information on assembling an "grab-and-go bag" and got acquainted with the procedure for receiving the "attention everyone!" signal. The experts talked about the protective structures of civil defense and psychological aspects of behavior during emergency situations.



January 23

Winners and finalists of the Responsibility Award 2021 were awarded in Kyiv.

The official awarding ceremony of the winners and finalists of the "Responsibility Award 2021", which was launched with the support of the Bohdan Gavrylyshyn Family Foundation, took place in the city of Kyiv. Among the finalists was the NGO "Educationally-analytical center of community development".



23 February 24-(25)

Training "Hear and see your organization: how to establish effective communication?"

The training brought together civil activists and employees of local self-government bodies, who seek to improve the communication of their organizations. The event could not be completed as a full-scale invasion began on February 24, 2022, so this was the last training we in pre-war period did.

March 2

Creation of a selection of information on the assistance of European countries to ukrainian refugees



March 28

As part of the "Pryvitne Ternopillya" initiative, a video clip was shot about the services, locations and services available to IDPs, a page was created on the website, and booklets with the necessary information were printed. The initiative was included among the best practices in Ukraine in the field of cooperation between civil society, business and government.

April 4

Survey of public organizations and activists

The purpose of the survey is to study the state of public organizations and their members during a full-scale war.



April 17

Transfer of books for children from Ukraine who are in Germany.

Many families who were forced to leave their homes by the war were hospitably received by Germany. Many children have gone to local kindergartens, and schoolchildren study remotely. In order to get along better with their peers, young Ukrainians started learning German. To facilitate the study of a foreign language, textbooks and other literature for the needs of Ukrainian families were transferred from Ukraine. The books were transferred from Lviv to Dresden.



April 6


Participation in the radio marathon "On the way to victory", presentation of the "Pryvitne Ternopil'ya" initiative.

The head of the NGO "Educationally-analytical center of community development" took part in the radio marathon "On the Road to Victory", organized by "Radio Na Dotyk". Residents of the Zaporizhzhia region, and not only, were able to learn about the situation with IDPs in the Ternopil oblast and the initiatives being implemented for them.



April 10

Collection of signatures for the creation of a coordinating body for the support and development of the public sector

April 18

As part of the "PRO school Ternopil" initiative in Ternopil, students arranged a new flower bed in the school yard.

As part of the "PRO school Ternopil" initiative, a modern flower bed appeared in the yard of Ternopil Secondary School No. 25, the landscape of which was developed by the school's students. The project "Landscape of flower beds in the school yard" was implemented by students and school management.



April 19

Community activists from Germany delivered animal feed to Ukraine.

Public activists organized the supply of fodder and veterinary medicines for animals. Humanitarian aid is transferred from Germany, where it is collected by activists. The first batch of fodder was donated to the civil organization "Western Ukrainian Society for the Protection of Animals", which works in the city of Lviv. Also, part of the aid was transferred to the city of Lozova of the Kharkiv region and the city of Sumy.



April 19

Online broadcast of the presentation of the results of the survey of public activists "Public organizations and activists during the war: state and prospects"

Webinar on "Registration of charitable and public organizations: step-by-step instructions"

The participants got acquainted with the key legal acts that regulate the process of registration of a civil or charitable organization during the period of martial law. The experts also analyzed the list of all the documents that will be required when registering a public or charitable organization.

June 3

Presentation of the project on the settlement of temporarily displaced persons "RE:Ukraine Ternopil region"

The large-scale project "RE:Ukraine Ternopil region" concerns the construction of housing for IDPs. In the Ternopil region, modular houses for displaced people will be built in the Zbarazh community. Thanks to the construction of such houses, it will be possible to provide housing for about 5,545 people.



June 27

Signing of a memorandum on cooperation with the National Association of Youth Advisors

During the presentation of the new NGO "National Association of Advisors on Youth Affairs" in Ternopil, memorandum was signed on cooperation with the NGO "Educationally-analytical center of community development". The documents define cooperation in the direction of informational support for initiatives, implementation of events for youth and development of communities in communities.

In the film, using the example of five domestic public organizations, it is shown what path Ukraine has taken with the support of partners.



August 12

Completion of the implementation of the initiative "Board games in the yard"

On International Youth Day, the implementation of the "Board Games in the Yard" initiative, which is part of our "PRO school Ternopil" project, was completed. In one of the yards, young people have arranged a place where you can play board games.



August 11

Participation in the "Summer School of Local Self-Government" project

Among the speakers of the project was Maksym Cherkashyn, head of the NGO "Educationally-analytical center of community development", who presented the achievements of the "Pryvitne Ternopil" project to the participants of the training program. The attendees got acquainted with the functioning of the information resource, which contains all the important information for forcibly displaced people.



August 23

Finalization of the fundraising strategy for 2022-2024, which was developed with the support of Isar Ednannia

Natalia Muzyka, trainer and facilitator of Isar Ednannia worked with our organization for several months. During this time, we managed to develop a high-quality fundraising strategy that will allow us to better attract resources for the implementation of initiatives and projects. We have a vision of our development and an understanding of what steps should be taken to achieve our goals.

The start of the implementation of the "See me" initiative



Training "Internal and external communication of a public organization during the war"

During the two-day training, the activists considered a number of issues related to the internal and external communication of a public organization during the war, including cooperation with the authorities, mass media, interaction with IDPs, digital communication, and others. For two days, experienced communication trainers worked with representatives of public organizations, including relocated ones.





